


## Web Search Tutorial

You are going to use the Internet to research a career that interests you. This tutorial will help you understand how to search for information using the search engine "Yahooligans". You will be able to find useful information about your chosen career and incorporate this information into your Career Presentation.



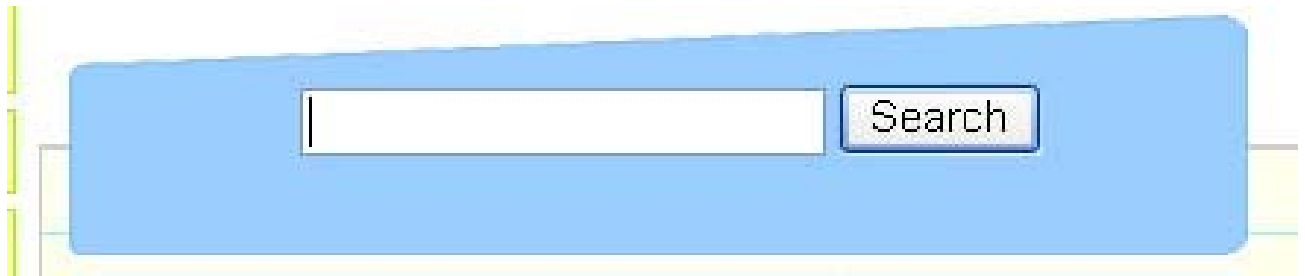
1. Double click the Internet Explorer symbol.
2. Type [www.yahooligans.com](http://www.yahooligans.com) in the address line and press Enter.

4. In the search box, type the career you are learning about.



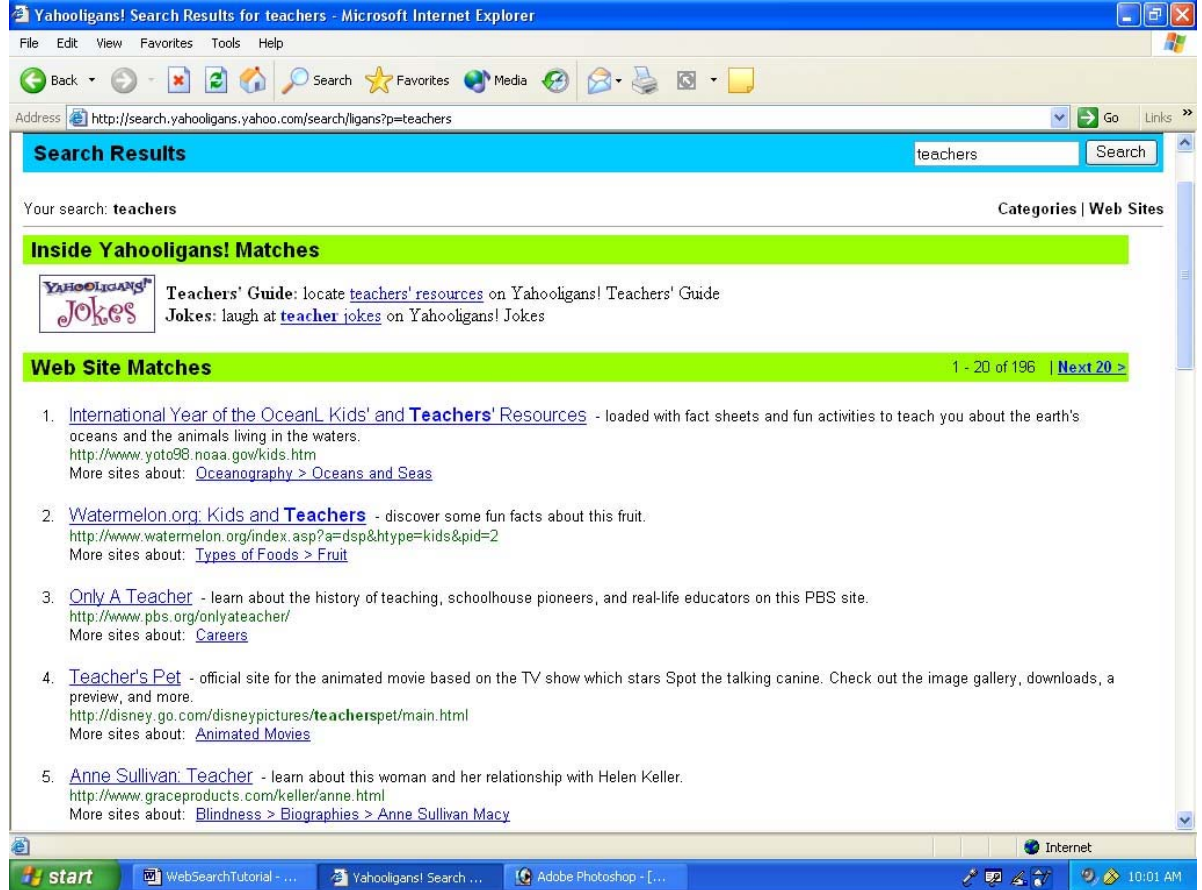
For example, if you were searching teachers, your search box would look like this:



5. Click on the rectangle that says "Search".



6. A page full of search results will appear. It will look something like this:



7. You can now click on any of the **Blue Titles** to learn more about your chosen career.
8. You should include information from at least two websites you find during this web search in your Career Presentation.
9. As you are researching, write down the important information from the website on a note card, and then write the website name and the website address on the back of your note card.
10. You will turn in a Bibliography Sheet with your presentation that lists the websites you used for information in your Career Presentation.

11. When you use a website for your Career Presentation, you should cite it like this on your Bibliography Sheet:

- a. Title of the Website, period, and then the website address inside brackets [ ].
- b. Example: **The Amazing World of Animals.**

12. You will type the websites you used on Word to make a Bibliography Sheet. Your Bibliography Sheet will look like this, but with the websites you used:
